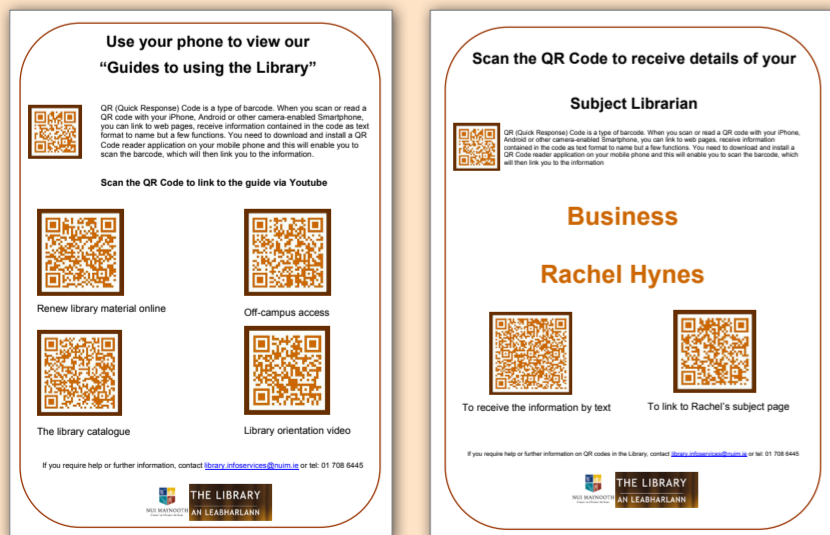
QR or 'Quick Retrieval' codes are two dimensional barcodes which can be scanned by a smart phone or other device to link to web content, text or images.

These codes are becoming increasingly evident in advertising and information campaigns because they provide an aesthetic alternative to URLs and text.

The Library, NUI Maynooth decided to harness the capabilities afforded by these codes in order to engage with users and facilitate flexible learning.

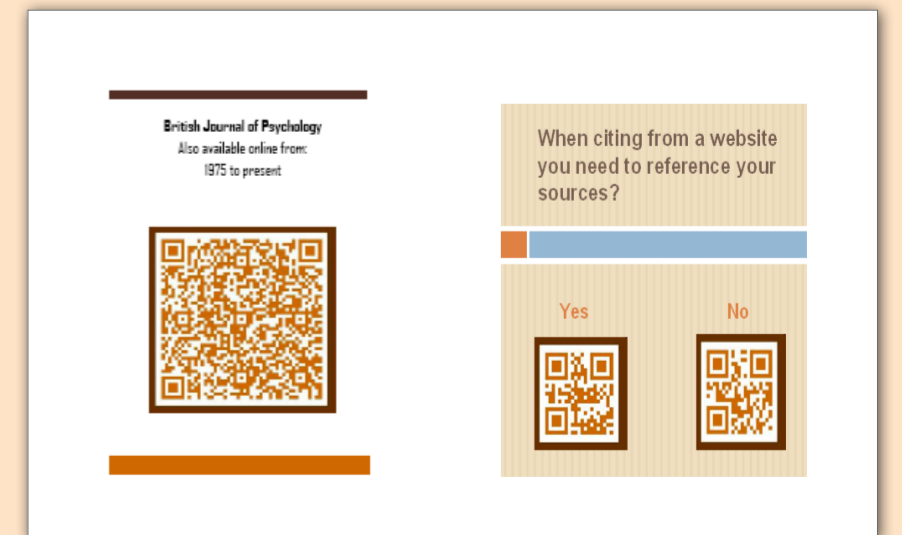
Linking to electronic guides and services & displaying subject librarian information
