Facilitate attendance at **Conferences**, **courses** & seminars *Community Development* - University & Beyond


This is a range of endeavours undertaken by the library to actively engage with the University, local and wider community to share our expertise and resources in recessionary times.


Supporting Maynooth Post Primary School in the establishment of a school library and through the provision of information skills training to Leaving Certificate students.
