College is for anyone; IT CAN BE YOU

This comic zine came from research we carried out in 2022 with 58 college students in 7 Further Education colleges in the greater Dublin area, where we asked them about their experience in college and their thoughts around progressing to university.

They told us that despite college having restored their confidence in themselves and their joy in learning, Further Education and Training is sometimes seen as 'not real college.' They also told us that university is 'for the rich' and that 'normal' people with bills and responsibilities struggle to find the means to continue in education. Despite this drawback, university was still perceived to be an important pathway to better life outcomes and opportunities, with the potential to be 'the start of something bigger.'
