- ➤ Avoiding Plagiarism
- Developing critical thinking skills

## Lessons learned:

- ➤ Hands on session and group discussions worked well in engaging students and developing critical thinking skills
- ➤ While technical skills were good it allowed us to establish there was a need for Information Literacy in Second Level Schools
- ➤ This programme has clear benefits for students' progression to third level education and the work place
- > Preparing the programme and working within a school timetable proved challenging
