Making NUI Maynooth eTheses available internationally

The Library, Graduate Studies & the Examinations Office worked together to design & deliver training in "How to submit an electronic version (PDF) of a thesis to the NUI Maynooth ePrints & eTheses Institutional Repository".

Researchers worldwide, then have access to the material 24/7, free of charge and from any device with internet access.



How it Worked:

Library training sessions timetable agreed & advertised by Graduate Studies Office.
Information sessions typically cover:

- Why to submit a thesis to the repository
- How to submit an electronic version to eTheses
- The NUI Maynooth Mandate & other research mandates
- Increasing the visibility of NUI Maynooth research output
- National and International eTheses projects

Lessons learned:

- Need to work closely with Graduate Studies
- Need to work closely with Examinations
- Need to promote benefits of depositing
- Need to deliver more information sessions
